The 2012 construction season is well underway with one home completed (Aurora, WI), three homes in progress (two in Kingsford and one in Norway) and three additional homes which will be started in the spring (two in Norway and one in Crystal Falls). One of the Kingsford homes is a rehab, the remainder of the homes are new construction.

Shown above is the Hamel house at 1801 Pisoni Street in Iron River, completed in November 2011. It was the second Habitat home in Iron County. Cars for Homes

Cars for Homes is a Habitat for Humanity International program to raise money for the affiliates through donations of cars, trucks, boats, RV's and other motorized vehicles.

If you have a vehicle you would like to donate to this program, call 1-877-277-4344 or go to the Cars for Homes website (www.carsforhomes.org).

Vehicles accepted into the program are processed by Advanced Remarketing Services, Inc., Habitat's national agent. They will handle title transfer, towing, and reporting.

Vehicles are sold through a network of auto auctions, recyclers, salvage yards, and the web. The proceeds go to HFHI who then distributes the funds to the donor's local affiliate.
