Habitat received a grant from the Dickinson Area Community Foundation to purchase a 24' car hauler to be turned into a tool trailer. In the past we have stored construction materials either in a pile on the ground, exposed to the elements, or inside the house project (once the house is framed in). The trailer will have a secure and dry space to store construction materials. Due to COVID-19 manufacturing delays, we received the trailer in early January 2021. The Core Crew will spend most of the winter organizing their new space.
